TheMusicClamp







I'm lucky if I can remember the chords and lyrics to 4-5 songs! When I first started playing the ukulele I downloaded dozens of songs from the internet and printed them out. Most are just one page, but when some are more, I condense them to one page for convenience. Then I bought a portable music stand to make it comfortable to play, but I found it wasn't so portable and was to bulky and heavy to carry around in my ukulele gig bags.







Well, I found other ukulele enthusiasts had the same complaint so, I invented TheMusicClamp, a Patent Pending sheet music holder that really is portable! It can clamp to any vertical or horizontal surface 318" to 1" thick. I have clamped it to tables, chairs, pop up canopies, beverage coolers, backpacks, branches, railings, shelves, cabinet doors, even the glove compartment door in my car when my wife is driving! It's preferable to clamp to anything other than your ukulele so there is no movement, but in a pinch you can even clamp to your ukulele! Clamping to the ukulele headstock is best when using one sheet of music in a position that eliminates bounce. You can use two sheets of



music with TheMusicClamp extended, but you will get a little bounce if you move to much while playing. I condense all my music to one sheet for that reason. You also can use it in capo mode! Great for any stringed instrument! The clamp and support arms are made from strong, lightweight aluminum alloy and include Bulldog paper clamps bolted all together with screws, nylon washers, and nylon insert locking nuts. About 5 ounces, total weight! The screws, nylon washers, and locking

nuts provide a firm, yet adjustable, pivot connection to allow 360 degree rotation of all parts for versatility. Positioning is up to your creativity!

A compact screwdriver and wrench are included should an occasional adjustment be necessary. Instructions and a convenient velvet drawstring bag are included. Collapses to about 9.5" and weighs about 5 ounces!
